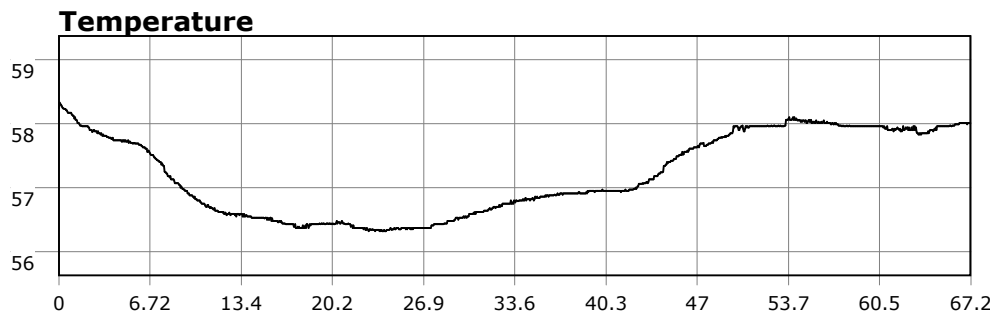

Equipment build: 7mm suit + vest w/hood; one light;
13lbs weight; camera no strobe.

Great dive at the reef despite being overcast. Vis was a good 15feet. Kelp has really become thick so a small light is useful. Camera fogged up despite having a dessicant in the case overnight. Never happened before. Naturally I missed tons of good shots. Saw many large sun stars, garibaldi, kelp bass, sheephead, tube anenomes, several large spanish shaws, perch. After about an hour we were all getting chilled so we headed in. Entry/exit was uneventful as the water was calm. Some of the guys saw an octopus but I missed it.
