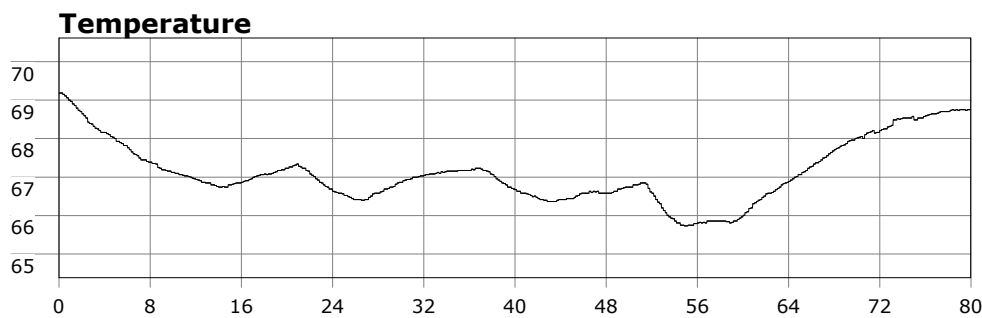
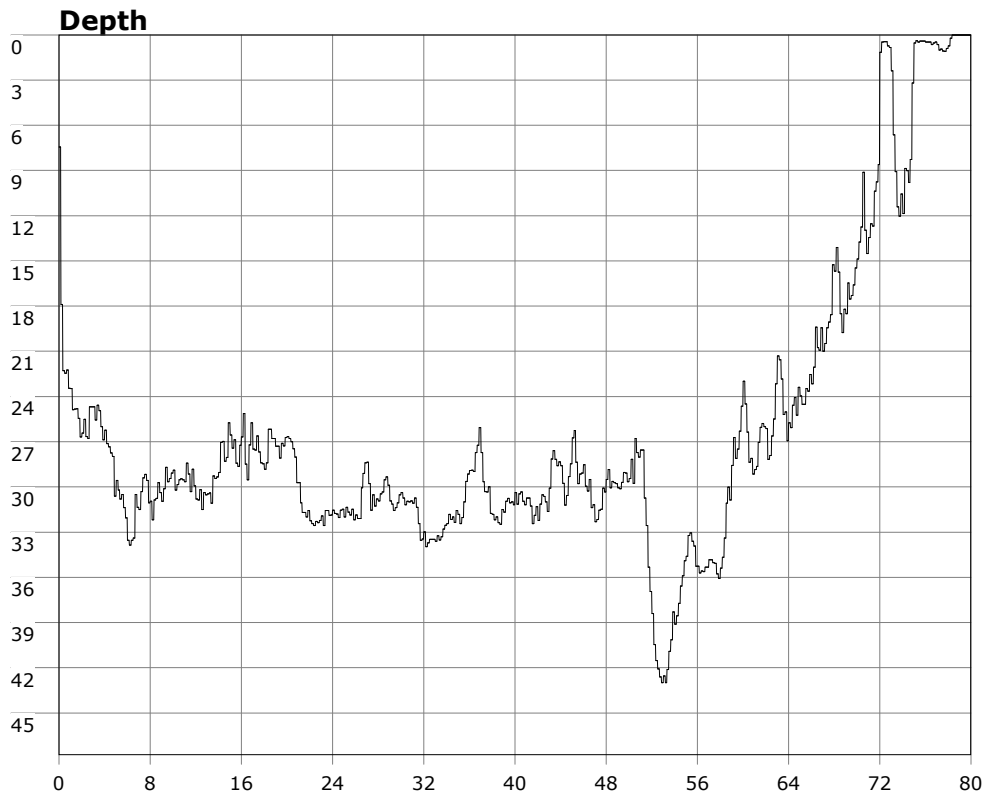

Equipment build: 7mm suit + vest w/hood; one light; 131lbs weight; camera with no strobe, spare air

Excellent dive today. Surf was calm making entry/exist easy. Bouyancy control and navigation were much better than normal and I made the entire dive w/out needing to surface for a bearing check. All the suspects were out today: garibaldi, sheephead to include a male, kelp bass, black jacks, greenlings, rock fish, sunstars, and even an octopus. The sunstar was more active than most, and the fish were all eager to say hello. The octopus was very well camouflaged, and once he knew he was spotted he slowly made his way to a hidey hole.
