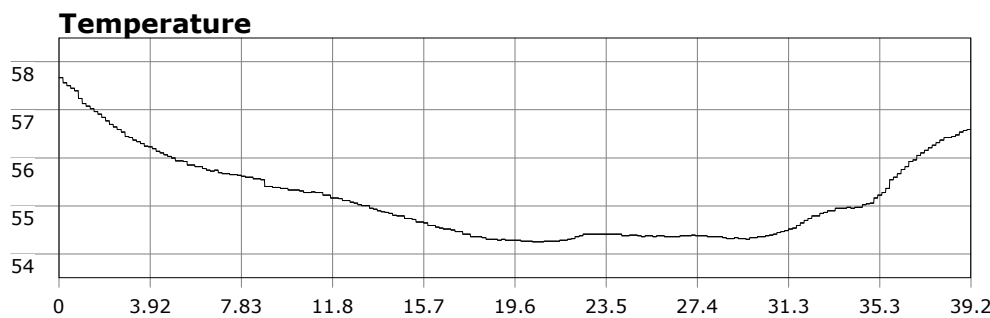

Equipment build: 7mm suit + vest w/hood; one light; 19 lbs weight, camera

Tough dive today at OML. Entry/exit required timing and patience to avoid trouble as some big waves were coming in. Vis was zero upon initial descent and just a few feet at best. There was a very strange circular surge on the bottom which made for a bumpy ride. No matter what direction I swam, I seemed to be kicking against it, and the kelp was whisking around pretty good. No special critters of note other than fat lemon dorids and a few female sheephead cruising around. This was a definite navigation dive.

On the plus side, the water is now a toasty 55 deg. .
