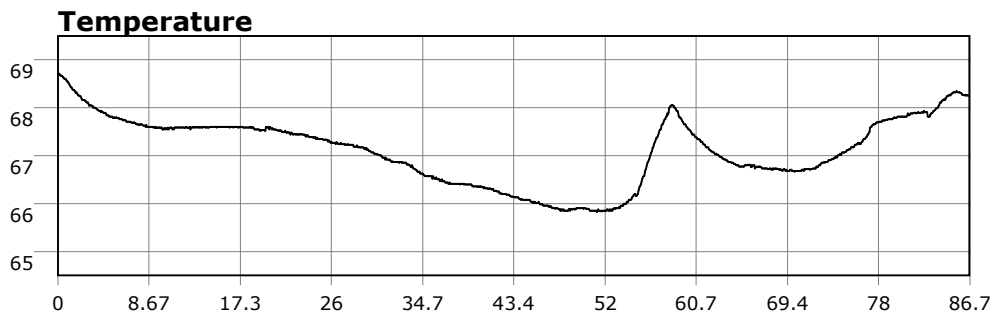

Equipment build: 7mm suit + vest w/hood; two small lights;
13lbs weight; camera no strobe and no pony bottle.

Second and yet another good dive at Malaga. Vis was 8-10ft but not very clear beyond 5ft. Plenty of wildlife today: Garibaldi (one juvenile), female sheephead, kelp bass, senioritas, surf perch, the biggest sea slug I've ever seen, and a greenling. As before I kicked out from the beach and went at about a 240 deg heading, lazily making my way over the structure and through the kelp. Played peek-a-boo with a greenling and once looked around to find myself being circled by 5-7 garibaldi--really cool. After about 45 min I surfaced just to check my location, and saw I was a little past the health club. Although I had tons of air, I decided to set a reciprical and head in. As with the entry, the exit was uneventful.
