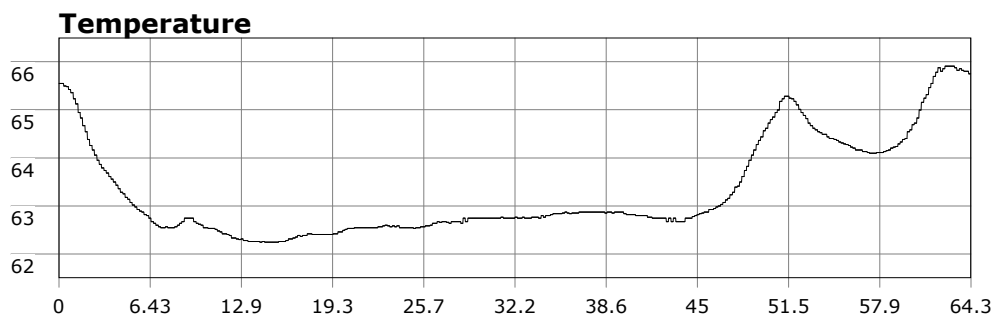

Equipment build: 7mm suit + vest w/hood; one light; 131lbs weight; camera with no strobe, spare air, knife

Good dive today w/ Rev Al at 120. Conditions looked fairly good w/ low swell and no foam on the surface. The tide was a bit low so we opted for 120. The water was a bit green as it has been the last few weeks. The green layer went away at about 25 feet and vis opened up to 10-12ft. Saw the usual fish, sunstars, a scorpion fish, and a small octopus tucked into a hidie hole. We headed east and north then south and finally west back home. There was a swift current on the surface blowing east, but it wasn't an issue down below.
