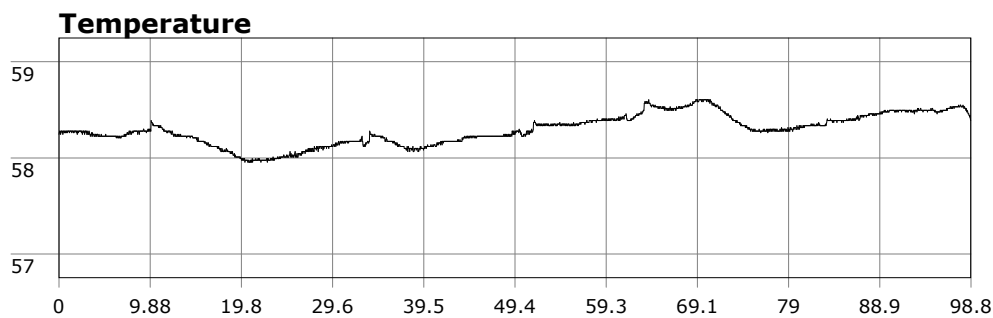
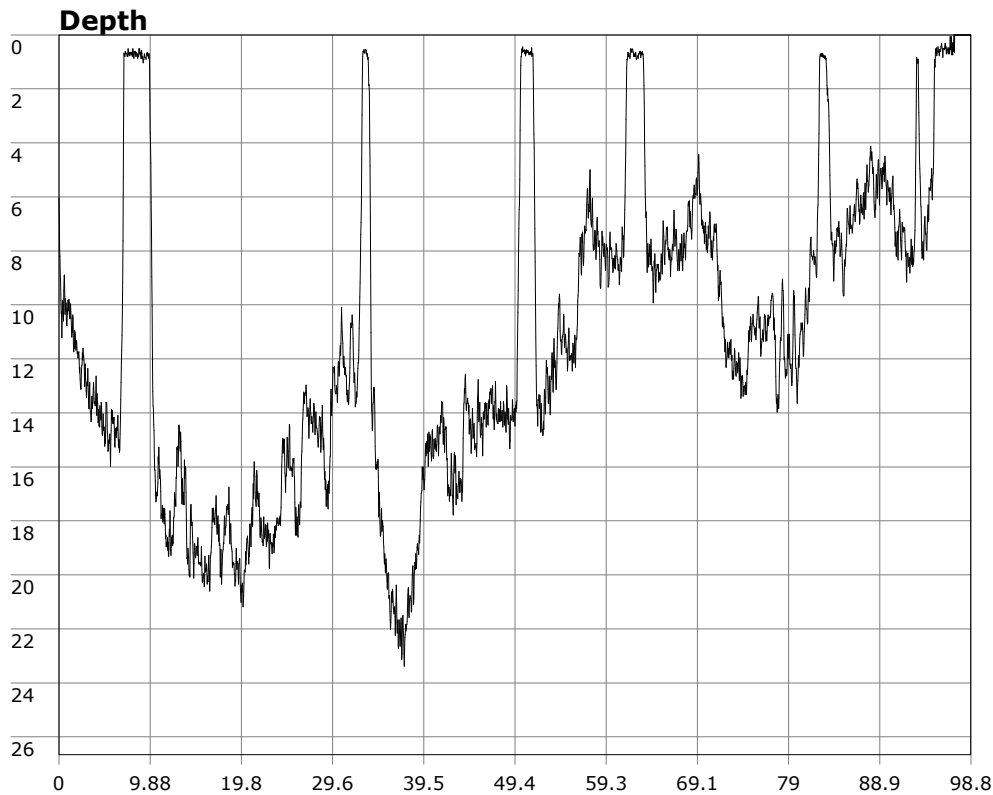

Given the vis yesterday, decided to hit Malaga again. Vis had dropped quite a bit. 6 ft was about it, but it was still diveable. Since the tide was a bit low, I went in at the beach and surface kicked towards the spa to drop down. Like yesterday, the surge on the bottom was fairly strong. I headed 240-270 deg for a long while before turning around. As before, saw many horn sharks today along with the usual kelp fish, garibaldi, and a short bug. Good but not great dive.
