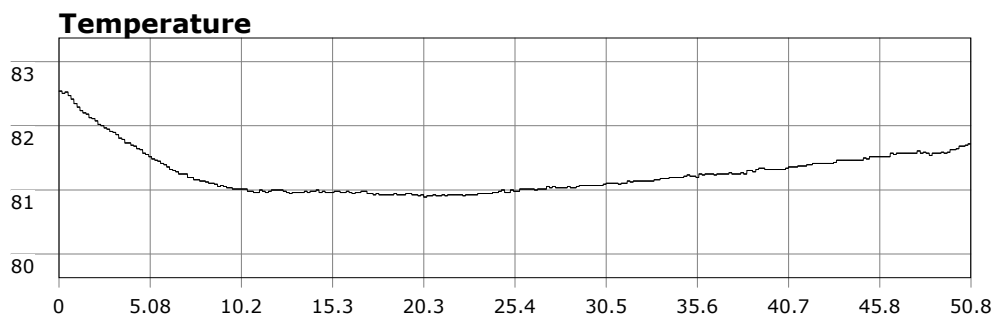
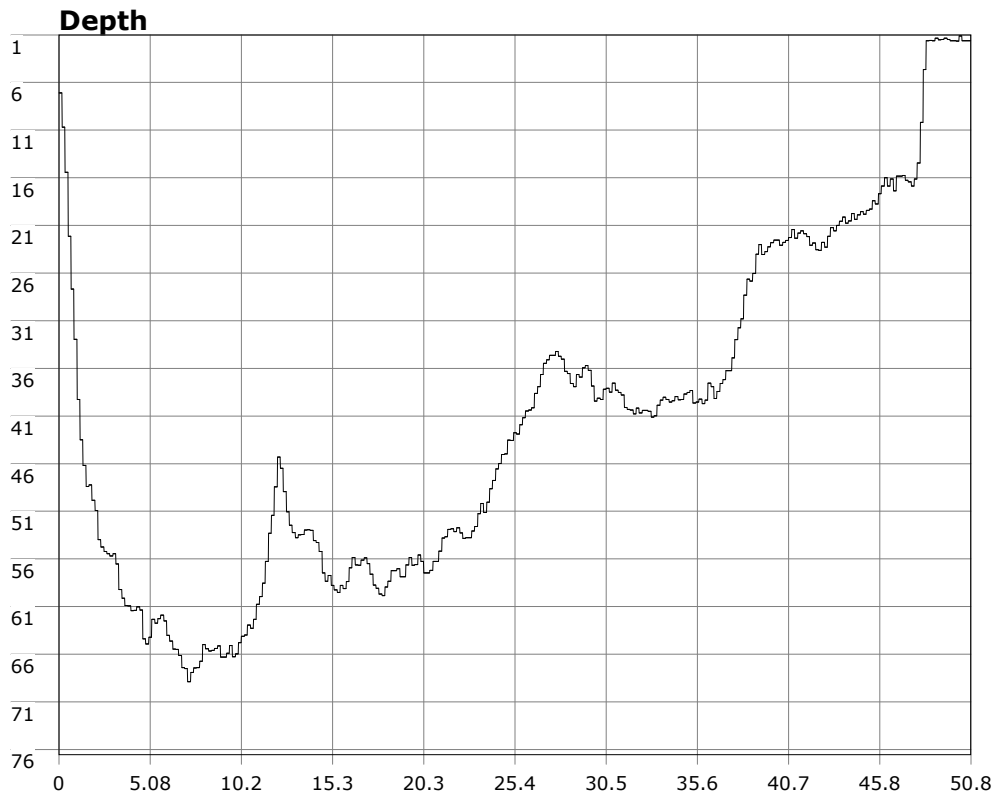

Equipment config: 3mm shortie, 9lbs weight, camera no strobe, spare air.

First dive in the DR and an excellent dive. Vis about 50ft w/water not as clear as say Hawaii (due to the sites being on the Atlantic side of the island). Not as many fish as Hawaii or say Bonaire but a wonderful reef structure. Many different types of colorful coral, no swell and no current made for a very relaxing dive. Max depth 69 ft but the structure went a good bit deeper. There was also a sandy area with the little eels that bob up and down--never seen those in person before. Other highlights included sea horses (which I've never seen in person before), a moray eel, some type of invertebrate with long legs, and a small ray. The guide was patient and very helpful. Just he and I on this dive so we could go wherever we wanted. Can't beat that.
